

**UNIFIED CARRIER LICENCE  
TELECOMMUNICATIONS ORDINANCE (Chapter 106)**

**WTT HK Limited (“WTT”)**

**W8. iQR Service**

Effective date: 12/8/12

The Service allows the Customer to create, download, and manage a matrix barcode (“iQR”). The iQR will allow the Customer to make available its pre-uploaded contents <sup>see Note 1</sup> to the end-users authorized by the Customer (the “End-users”) over the Internet upon the End-users’ scanning of the iQR using WTT’s iQR Scanner (“Scanner”).

To be able to receive the Customer’s contents, the End-users must first download and install the iQR Scanner on their mobile telecommunications devices <sup>see Note 2</sup>. The Customer has the option of subscribing to iQR Scanner affiliation program that allows a designated iQR Scanner to be used exclusively by the Customer and its End-users.

The Service allows the Customer to host and store its contents on WTT’s servers. If the Customer’s actual data transfer volume and/or storage as recorded by WTT exceed(s) the limit(s) stipulated in the Service Plan(s) subscribed by the Customer, additional charge(s) will be levied as follows without further notice.

The End-users are responsible for their own Internet connection and WTT is not responsible for any charges imposed by the mobile service providers on the End-users.

The Customer shall not use the Service for any purposes not authorized by WTT or for any unlawful or immoral purposes and shall indemnify WTT for any losses or damages sustained.
